

Solo & Feature Spot Requirements

Solo:

- Home club member in good standing.
- Passed the Juvenile Freestyle test or higher by January 31.
- Must skate a total of 55 hours of club ice between September and the end of April (pre-registration or walk-on) Junior coaching up to 15 hours (approved by the Director) can be used to meet the 55 hour requirement. Ice time is accumulated and tracked in terms of minutes on the ice, not sessions. Learn to Skate and Synchronized skating hours do not count.
- Must skate in a group number, (synchro number does not satisfy this requirement).
- Music must fit show theme and be approved by the Director.
- Skater is responsible for their own music, choreography and costume (approved by the Director).
- Performing both nights will depend on the number of eligible skaters in any given year.
- Music length:
Juvenile: 2 minutes and 15 sec. +/- 10 sec.
Intermediate: 2:30 minutes +/- 10 sec.
Novice: 3:00 minutes +/- 10 sec.
Junior & Senior: 3:30 minutes +/-10 sec.

Graduating Senior Solo

- Home club member in good standing.
- Must skate a total of 55 hours of club ice between September and the end of April (pre-registration or walk-on) Junior coaching up to 15 hours (approved by the Director) can be used to meet the 55 hour requirement. Ice time is accumulated and tracked in terms of minutes on the ice, not sessions. Learn to Skate and Synchronized skating hours do not count.
- Skater must also skate in a group number, (synchro number does not satisfy this requirement).
- Skater is responsible for their own music, choreography and costume (approved by the Director).
- Music length must be appropriate to skating level.
- Graduating Seniors will perform on both nights.

Featured Spot:

- Home club member in good standing.
- Must skate a total of 55 hours of club ice between September and the end of April (pre-registration or walk-on) Junior coaching up to 15 hours (approved by the Director) can be used to meet the 55 hour requirement. Ice time is accumulated and tracked in terms of minutes on the ice, not sessions. Learn to Skate and Synchronized skating hours do not count.
- Passed the Pre-Preliminary Freestyle test by January 31.
- Must skate in a group number (synchro number does not satisfy this requirement)
- Music will be assigned by the Director
- Skater is responsible for their own costume (approved by the Director) and choreography. Music is assigned by Director.
- Performing both nights will depend on the number of eligible skaters in any given year.
- Music length will be in the range of 45 seconds to 1:25 minutes

Adult Solo:

- Home club member in good standing.
- Must skate a total of 36 hours of club ice between September and the end of April (pre-registration or walk-on) Junior coaching up to 15 hours (approved by the Director) can be used to meet the 36 hour requirement. Ice time is accumulated and tracked in terms of minutes on the ice, not sessions. Learn to Skate and Synchronized skating hours do not count.
- Passed the Adult Silver Freestyle test or Juvenile Freestyle test by January 31.
- Must skate in the Adult or Dance number
- Music must fit the theme of the show and be approved by the Director
- Skater is responsible for their own costume, music, and choreography
- Music length: up to 2 minutes

Adult Featured Spot:

- Home club member in good standing.
- Must skate a total of 36 hours of club ice between September and the end of April (pre-registration or walk-on) Junior coaching up to 15 hours (approved by the Director) can be used to meet the 36 hour requirement. Ice time is accumulated and tracked in terms of minutes on the ice, not sessions. Learn to Skate and Synchronized skating hours do not count.
- Passed the Adult Bronze Freestyle test or Pre-preliminary Freestyle test by January 31.
- Adult featured skaters will usually be highlighted out of the Adult group number.
- Performing both nights will depend on the number of eligible skaters in any given year.
- Skater is responsible for their own costume (approved by the Director) and choreography. Music assigned by Director.
- Music length will be in the range of 1:00 – 2:00 minutes

Any of these requirements may be appealed to the Executive Board.
